

ORDINANCE NO. 478

"AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 474 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PERKINS, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 474 amending Section 5-4-2 of the Perkins City Code is hereby rescinded and a portion of the former verbiage of Section 5-4-2 of the Perkins City Code is reinstated, to-wit:

5-4-2: LIMITATION OF PURCHASE, POSSESSION OR USE OF FIREWORKS:

A. Hours Permitted: The use or discharge of fireworks within the corporate limits of the city is hereby prohibited, except between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) A.M. and twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight on July 4 of each year, except as further provided in section 5-4-4 of this chapter.


B. Distance To Specific Facilities; State Imposed Burn Ban: The use of fireworks within the corporate limits of the city is hereby prohibited within three hundred feet (300') of any school, church, public building, nursing home, medical facility, service station, convenience store or any facility selling and dispensing petroleum products, and from within three hundred feet (300') of any commercial business and at any location within the corporate limits of the city during a state imposed burn ban.

C. Bottle Rockets Prohibited: The use of pop bottle rockets within the corporate limits of the city is expressly prohibited at all times.

SECTION 2: Emergency Clause It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.


